About the Organization:

HEAL Palestine was founded on January 1, 2024, as a nonprofit organization dedicated to helping children in Palestine, with a special focus on Gaza children, using a holistic approach that empowers our volunteer community globally. Our focus is on building programs that help heal children and give them opportunities in Health, Education, Aid, and Leadership (HEAL).

Overview of Position:

HEAL Palestine is seeking a compassionate and dedicated Social Worker to join our Global Healing Program team. The Social Worker will play a crucial role in supporting the social and emotional needs of injured and sick children receiving medical care abroad. They will work closely with host families, communities, medical professionals, and volunteers to ensure the well-being of each child during their treatment stay.

Primary Responsibilities:

1. Assess the social and emotional needs of each child receiving medical care and develop individualized care plans to address those needs.
2. Work closely with host families and communities where children are being treated to provide support, guidance, and advocacy.
3. Organize and coordinate all appointments for children during their stay, including medical appointments, therapy sessions, and follow-up care.
4. Communicate regularly with families back in the Middle East to provide updates on the child's progress.
5. Collaborate with the local community of volunteers to provide additional support and resources for the child and their guardian.
6. Provide counseling and emotional support to children and their families, helping them cope with the challenges of receiving medical care abroad.

7. Advocate for the best interests of the child within the medical system and ensure their needs are being met and the rights are respected throughout their treatment.
8. Support all other aspects of the child's care and needs during their stay abroad, including administrative tasks and logistical arrangements.
9. Ability to travel and meet the children, host families, medical staff and communities as needed.

Qualifications:

1. Bachelor's or Master's degree in Social Work, healthcare administration, or public health.
2. Previous experience working in social work, patient care, or case management, preferably in a healthcare or humanitarian setting.
3. Proficiency in Arabic and English languages, with strong written and verbal communication skills in both languages.
4. Excellent interpersonal skills and the ability to build rapport with children, families, and community members.
5. Strong organizational and administrative skills, with the ability to manage multiple tasks and priorities effectively.
6. Empathy, compassion, and a genuine desire to make a positive difference in the lives of vulnerable children and their families.
